

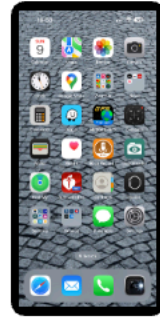
Evacuation

List of Go Bag Contents:

Go Bag should be easily accessible and filled with items needed to help you quickly and safely evacuate your home. When a wildland fire is approaching, you may only have enough time to retrieve this bag . . .



- ✦ Clothing and personal toiletries
- ✦ Bedding (sleeping bags, pillows)
- ✦ Medications and prescriptions
- ✦ Prescription eyewear
- ✦ Computers with chargers
- ✦ Mobile phones with chargers
- ✦ Family photos
- ✦ Keepsakes & heirlooms
- ✦ Cash, credit cards, etc.
- ✦ **Important documents**
- ✦ First aid kit
- ✦ Multi-tool, can opener
- ✦ Flashlight & extra batteries
- ✦ Radio (battery powered & batteries)
- ✦ Bottled water & snacks
- ✦ N-95 masks
- ✦ Special equipment for special needs / elderly
- ✦ Toys & supplies for children
- ✦ Supplies for pets (food, leash, crate, etc.)



- ✦ Prescriptions & Rx eyewear
- ✦ Birth & marriage certificates
- ✦ Pictures of pet(s) for ID purpose
- ✦ Passports
- ✦ Drivers license & personal ID
- ✦ Social security cards
- ✦ Insurance policies (home, auto, life +)
- ✦ Recent tax returns
- ✦ Employment information
- ✦ Wills & deeds
- ✦ Stocks, bonds, & other negotiable instruments
- ✦ Financial information (bank, savings, retirement account numbers, etc.)
- ✦ Home inventory (list/photo/video)
- ✦ Contact information for family, friends & physicians
