

Go Bag Contents

- ✧ **THE LIST** in the top of the bag *
- ✧ Medications and prescriptions
- ✧ Important documents
 - **DIGITIZED** if possible !
- ✧ Clothing and personal toiletries
- ✧ Bedding (sleeping bags, pillows)
- ✧ Prescription eyewear
- ✧ Computers with chargers
- ✧ Mobile phones with chargers
- ✧ Family photos
- ✧ Cash, credit cards, etc.
- ✧ First aid kit
- ✧ Multi-tool, can opener
- ✧ Flashlight & extra batteries
- ✧ Radio (battery powered & batteries)
- ✧ Bottled water & snacks
- ✧ N-95 masks
- ✧ Special equipment for special needs / elderly
- ✧ Toys & supplies for children
- ✧ Supplies for pets (food, leash, crate, etc.)

Go Bag should be easily accessible and filled with items needed to help you quickly and safely evacuate your home. When a wildland fire is approaching, you may only have enough time to retrieve this bag . . .

- ✧ Prescriptions & Rx for eyewear
- ✧ Birth & marriage certificates
- ✧ Pictures of pet(s) for ID purpose
- ✧ Passports
- ✧ Drivers license & personal ID
- ✧ Social security cards
- ✧ Insurance policies (home, auto, life +)
- ✧ Recent tax returns
- ✧ Employment information
- ✧ Wills & deeds
- ✧ Stocks, bonds, & other negotiable instruments
- ✧ Financial information (bank, savings, retirement account numbers, etc.)
- ✧ Home inventory (list/photos/video)
- ✧ Contact information for family, friends & physicians

* Things that you take with you and your Go-Bag at the last minute:

- ✧ High value items
- ✧ Keepsakes & Heirlooms
- ✧ Valuable collectables
- ✧ Cherished, irreplaceable items
- ✧ Artwork
